

Arthur Getis Intro To Geography 13th Edition

Spatial data analysis has seen explosive growth in recent years. Both in mainstream statistics and econometrics as well as in many applied fields, the attention to space, location, and interaction has become an important feature of scholarly work. The methods developed to deal with problems of spatial pattern recognition, spatial autocorrelation, and spatial heterogeneity have seen greatly increased adoption, in part due to the availability of user friendly desktop software. - Pattern analysis
- Local statistics
- Applications
