

Bon Voyage Level 3 Teacher Edition

With the objectives of the KS3 Framework, this title is a four-stage multimedia French course, designed to meet the requirements of the National Curriculum and the demands of the GCSE examination for a wide-ability range of students. It is also suitable for students studying other UK curricula.

With this text, teachers can select the material they present in depth based on the abilities, needs, and interests of their students. The text is divided into eight chapters that adhere to a very general theme as indicated in the chapter title—Les voyages, La santé, etc. Each chapter contains short lessons on Culture, Conversation, Language, Review Grammar, Journalism, Advanced Grammar, and Literature.

This innovative book is designed to help educators develop a better understanding of the Common Core through the processes of teacher and student enquiry. It is grounded in the premise that teacher inquiry is a logical mechanism with which teachers and administrators can gain insights into the standards, what they mean for teachers and students, and how the Common Core can be actualized within the reality of teachers' everyday work with students in the classroom. At the same time it advocates that teachers engage students in the process of inquiry in the classroom as a central means of helping them meet the new standards.

Designed to meet the needs of wide-ability classes, the Camarades French course is divided into four units and fulfils the criteria of the National Curriculum/5-14 Guidelines, fully preparing all pupils for GCSE/Standard Grade examinations. The Teacher's Book contains an overview of each unit; offers clear, concise teaching notes; provides notes for the four assessment sections and the answers to all Pupil's Book exercises; and comprises tapescripts in sequence that are highlighted for ease of reference.

Lists galore provide endless inspiration for any teacher. Many have introductory notes with background information and suggestions for educational use. Some lists are accompanied by worksheets and activities. For example, after the Abbreviations list, students identify abbreviations in telephone messages and rewrite them using complete words. In the spirit of the book, here's a list of topics covered: words, spelling, writing, communication, literature, math, science, the environment, social studies, art and music, and teacher and family references.
