As coalition forces, led by brave Iraqi soldiers on the ground, slowly pushed ISIS out, the brutality of the terrorists was turned against thousands of civilians as they fled the fighting. Four team members were wounded and one killed as they lived out that conviction with total commitment. This is their story.

Some are stories of success, but there are also stories of failures.
